- **Plant Care & Fencing:** To ensure the sustainability of the plantation, all plants were protected with bamboo fencing. Additionally, the club requested school management to assign one student to mentor each plant. Students who successfully maintain their assigned plant for two consecutive years will receive an award. A formal report will be submitted by the Service Committee Chair upon the finalization of all financial tasks.
- **Funding & Sponsorship:** Participating members contributed Rs 500 each, generating an initial total of Rs 7,000. President Rtn. Rupak Das Tamrakar provided a 100% matching grant, raising the collective total to Rs 14,000. Any remaining balance required for the project will be funded through the Sunshine Fund.
