The program was conducted in collaboration with the Kyonjomsom Committee and local community members of Bhardev, whose participation and support contributed significantly to the success of the activity. Their involvement strengthened community ownership and encouraged continued care for the plantation site. As part of the program, Rotarians revisited the plantation area to monitor the trees planted last year. It was encouraging to see that the previously planted trees are growing well, demonstrating the importance of regular care, follow-up, and cooperation with local stakeholders. This year, the team planted Dhupi, Kapoor, and various other tree species to increase green cover, promote biodiversity, and contribute to the long-term environmental sustainability of the area. The program also encouraged fellowship among Rotarians, Spouse and family participation, with Rotaractors and children from the Spouse Group joining the activity. The visit was combined with a pilgrimage and hiking experience, involving approximately 1.5 hours of hiking to reach and explore the area. From a Public Image perspective, the activity highlighted Rotary's commitment to environmental protection, community partnership, and sustainable service. Through collaboration with the Kyonjomsom Committee and local residents, the program demonstrated how Rotary brings people together to create meaningful and lasting community impact.
